



2010 "1331" Bugay Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon

Our first Cabernet is sourced from the Bugay Vineyard in Sonoma Valley. Owners John and Reta Bugay found this remote site high in the Mayacamas Mountains and fell in love with its rugged terrain and incredible beauty. With vineyard sites above the fog at 1,200 feet and soils that are volcanic in composition, we agree that this is a great place to grow Cabernet.

The 1331 Cabernet has deep plum and chocolate aromas with rich, opulent plum flavors. Complex smoky oak notes, moderate tannins and great underlying structure make this a great wine for the cellar.
