Our Vin Blancs is a bright, rich wine that first presents a full range of floral notes, honeysuckle and citrus blossom aromas. These carry into the palate and mesh perfectly with ripe nectarine and peach flavors, while the mid palate brings layers of more stone fruit, a sense of minerality and toasted honey. The lush mouthfeel and bracing acidity provide the perfect balance to the wine.
