



2012 3BB Pinot Noir

Our 3BB Pinot Noir is, as its name describes, a blend of three of the best barrels of the vintage. We were looking to make a blend that was a little weightier than our other Pinots. Two of our Sonoma Coast barrels fit with that goal and the one barrel from Green Valley added some deep cherry and cola notes that really made this blend sing.

The aromas have a richness that overflows from the glass with creamy strawberry mingling with orange zest and classic cherry and cola notes. On the palate, a rich vanilla essence blends with black cherry and cola flavors with notes of anise, ruby plum, orange marmalade and a bit of coffee and tea. Soft and lush, the finish is held together by a fine and long tannin structure.

We think the 3BB is drinking great now, and will continue to do so for the next 5 to 7 years.
